

## SCOA Chairman's report, 15/6/17

### **SCOA Championships**

Since the last meeting the SCOA Championships were held at Hambleden by TVOC and went very well. The constant aerial displays by kites was very distracting for the chairman! Many thanks to TVOC for hosting and to Liz for organising the medals.

### **JK17**

Several SCOA members did very well at the JK – too many to mention them all, but winners were:

Carol Edwards (TVOC) 1<sup>st</sup> W60 Sprint (by 2 seconds!), Frank Townley (SN) 1<sup>st</sup> M14 over days 2&3, Martin Wilson (BKO) 1<sup>st</sup> M70 on days 2&3 and 2<sup>nd</sup> on the Sprint, Fiona Bunn (TVOC) 1<sup>st</sup> W18 on the Sprint and over days 2&3, Sarah Rollins (SN) 1<sup>st</sup> W40 on days 2&3 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Sprint, Jane Morgan (SOC) 1<sup>st</sup> W55 over days 2&3 and finally the winning SN Mini Relay team of Jocie Hilton, Laura Bennett and Tommy Rollins.

Special congratulations to Liz Yeadon on being awarded Coach of the Year – well deserved.

### **JK19**

There is a separate update for the JK2019, requiring a number of important and urgent actions. In particular, the region needs to decide whether to enter into a partnership agreement with BO or take on the whole risk ourselves and pay BO the super-levy.

### **SCOA League**

The 9 SCOA League events for 2017-17 have taken place with final results on the website. This year the average attendance was 120 per event, down from 140 in 2015/16 but the same as 2014/15.

Although we have had some discussion and chosen a scoring strategy for an Inter-Club challenge, other issues have come to light, so there is more to discuss at the meeting. The first event of the new season is 8 Oct, so decisions now would be good but could be deferred to the 21<sup>st</sup> September meeting if really necessary. Please see separate sheet.
