Thank you to those who have responded to requests for suggestions as to content. Jerry will be working to improve the site once the changes to the SCoA League database have been made.

Funding for Orienteers

The proposition that funding for those competing in international competitions and training camps be split three ways, 33% athlete, 33% club and 33% SCoA has been put to clubs and the feedback so far is positive on the whole for a change in SCoA policy. Clubs are understandably keen to maintain discretion as to how much they contribute. The issue I see is where some clubs have a low ceiling as to how much they are prepared to pay out in a year to an athlete. This could have a significant impact on those who are selected for multiple events.

The Orienteering Foundation

Christine Currie (SOC) has kindly offered to take over as the SCoA representative from Alun Jones (TVOC). Do remember that the Foundation offers funding to individuals and clubs, so if you are aware of a worthy cause, do contact Christine. Many thanks to Alun for representing SCoA over the years.

Moving forward, Jerry Newcombe is working to move the SCOA League to a new database which will make uploading results a good deal easier.

Your thoughts would be appreciated as to some proposed rule changes:

1. The current rules state that the League Score is based on the best results for 50% (rounded up to the next whole number) of all the events. This gives the following maximums based on total number of events in a season. The effect of increasing the percentage if we want to encourage more participation is as follows. Should we go for 50% or 66.6%?

2. There is no minimum number of event scores that must be obtained to qualify for a league score and prize. Should this be introduced? The suggestion is that we should set a minimum of 2, but 3 would also be an option. Do note the low numbers on the shorter courses, so possibly two rules with the lower figure for the white, Yellow and orange courses?
